This Will was proved at London before the Reverend George Paul Doctor of Laws Surrogate of the Right Worshipful John Betherworth also Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted the twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty eight by the Oaths of Lydia Hagg Widow the Relict of the deceased Benjamin Butcher and James Butcher the Executors named in the said Will to whom administration was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattells and Credits of the said deceased being first sworn duly to administer. &c.
