in the parish of Westminster in the County of Oxford with
two pieces or parcels of Garden Ground situate behind the said
Messuage or Tenement and all that piece of Ground or Grass
plot leading down to the River being the Land belonging to
and now occupied with the said Messuage or Tenement also
all those two pieces or parcels of Arable Land situate lying
and being in the front of the said Messuage or Tenement and
containing together by Estimation fourteen Acres be the same
more or less together with a Barn situate in a Yard belonging
to a small Messuage or Tenement therein after devised with a
right of passage through the said Yard to and from the said
Barn for Horses Carts and any other Carriages at all times
lawful I also give devise and bequeath to my son James

 residue and remainder of my household goods, implements of
 Trade Estate and Effects whatsoever after the payment of my
 Just Dots and funeral Expenses to be equally divided between
 them on Condition and to the intent that they shall pay the
 several legacies hereafter mentioned within the space of two
 years next after my decease that is to say to my eldest
 Daughter Mary Marty One Guinea for a Ring if she will
 accept thereof to my Daughter Mary Dolt the sum of five
 pounds or lawful Money of Great Britain and to my Daughters
 Martha Grainger Elizabeth Dolt Sarah Weatherhead and Jane
 Dolt the sum of five pounds each of like lawful Money of
 Great Britain but in case either or any of my said Daughters
 or my said Grand Daughter shall happen to die before
 the said legacies shall become due and payable then I
 give the share or shares of her or them so dying to my
 said sons equally between them and lastly I do hereby
 nominate constitute and appoint my said sons John Dolt
 and James Dolt joint Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament whereby revoking all former Wills and Testaments
 by me made I do acknowledge and declare this to be
