also my Library unto my said son Rivers Francis Grindall to be delivered
to him by my Executors hereafter named immediately after my decease
also all and every the interest dividends and profits which shall
annually arise and become due and payable from and out of all and every
the capital stock monies rents & now have or may hereafter be possessed

 legacies and to discharge my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses
 as after mentioned) together with all the interest and dividends thereon
 and from time to time to arise and become due and payable for the
 same unto my said son Rivers Francis Gindall and executors administrators
 and assigns assigns and assignables nevertheless to and with her in
 payment of one clear annuity or sum of seventy pounds yearly and of
 every year unto Mary Ann young Spinster now living with me
 for and during her natural life also I hereby give and bequeath as
 to my said wife Katherine Owen Mary Ann Platanus Gindall the
 use of the whole of my plate linen raiment household goods and of all
 furniture (except the gold and silver articles aforesaid specifically
 given and bequeathed to my said son Rivers Francis Gindall) which
 shall be in my dwellinghouse at the time of my decease so that we
 occupy and possess the same during her life and from and immediately
 after her decease I give and bequeath the said plate linen raiment
 household goods and furniture unto my said son Rivers Francis
 Gindall and executors administrators and assigns also I give and bequeath unto
 my friend John Dickenson Esquire of Saint John Street London one
 hundred pounds to purchase a ring and mourning unto my godson
 Richard Gindall Esquire and Francis Gindall Esquire one hundred pounds
 each and to my goddaughter Charlotte Agnes Maria Hall one of
 hundred pounds unto my brother in law John Holt and the Reverend
 Francis Hastings and my sister Marcella Holt and Jane Hastings each a
 mourning ring all which said several last mentioned legacies and of my
 mourning rings I will and direct shall be raised paid and provided by
 my said wife and Executors out of my said Capital stock monies and
 aforesaid mentioned and I hereby give full power and authority to
 my said wife to sell out and dispose of so much of the principal of these
 same as will be adequate thereto and also to pay and satisfy all my just
 debts funeral expenses and the charges of proving this my will and of
 carrying the same into execution also all the interest and dividend of my money
 goods chattels and effects of what nature or kind soever not aforesaid
 before specifically given I give and bequeath unto my said son Rivers
 Francis Gindall and executors administrators and assigns and lastly I do
 hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife Katherine Owen
 Mary Ann Platanus Gindall sole Executrix of this my last will and
 Testament whereby revoking all former and other will and wills by me at
 any time aforesaid made In witness whereof I the said Richard Gindall
 the testator have to this my last will and Testament contained in three
 sheets of paper to the first two sheets thereof set my hand and to the
 third and last sheet thereof set my hand and seal the twentieth day of
 September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve
