be possessed of such stock funds or Securities in their  
or discretion the said one thousand pounds shall  
be so laid out and invested in Trust for the said  
Dividends and Interest thereof as and when the  
same shall from time to time become due and  
payable and pay the same into my dear and  
beloved Aunt Elizabeth Holt the wife of the

 pounds shall be there invested to the use of the  
 of the said Robert Holt and after payment of  
 the said several Sums of one hundred and fifty  
 pounds and fifty two pounds Ten Shillings one  
 thousand five hundred pounds and one thousand  
 pounds I do direct that my said Trustee do  
 lay out and invest in the Estates of my Executors  
 hereinafter named one thousand five hundred  
 pounds of life lawful Money the part of the  
 said four thousand five hundred pounds in the  
 purchase of three pounds per Cent Consolidated  
 Bank Annuities of 60 years and continue the  
 same in the East India where the same were  
 at Interest and that they my said Executors  
 and the Survivor and Survivor of them and  
 Executors and administrators do stand possessors of  
 or interested in the three pounds per Cent  
 Consolidated Bank Annuities so to be purchased  
 in trust to receive the Dividends and Interest  
 thereof half yearly as and when the same

shall from time to time become due and payable  
and that they do pay and apply such said  
yearly dividends and interest in manner following  
that is to say Twelve pounds ten shillings part  
thereof during the life of my dear Aunt Ann  
Emball Spinster to her my said Aunt for her  
maintenance and such moneys as shall be paid for

and liable to the payment of the aforesaid  
years and proportions of the said dividends and  
interest to the said Ann Emballe and Henry  
Ann Carlotta shall respectively upon trust to  
transfer and pay one third part of the said  
ten per cent Consolidated Annuities or such other  
annuities the said last mentioned sum of one thousand  
five hundred pounds shall be invested or shall  
remain as aforesaid into the said John Holt  
and Richard Holt or the survivor of them and  
their Executors Administrators to for and upon trust  
and the same trusts as are hereinbefore mentioned  
and referred to respectively the aforesaid sum of one  
thousand pounds hereinbefore bequeathed to the said

and Richard Holt and the survivor of them  
and their Executors and Administrators do pay and apply

all sure sum and sum of money as they or  
 either of them shall or may actually receive within  
 the first year after my decease as or for  
 the first division or product of the said four or  
 thousand five hundred pounds or any part thereof  
 as part of the residue of what I may have to  
 dispose of and that all other sum or sums of  
 money which they shall or may receive afterwards  
 as or for sure the first division or product as or  
 for the said or so distribute divide and pay unto or  
 among the several persons hereinbefore mentioned  
 and the residue of what I have to dispose of in the  
 proportions I have hereinbefore and hereinafter directed  
 the said four thousand five hundred pounds to be  
 divided amongst them and all the rest residue  
 and remainder of the said four thousand five  
 hundred pounds and all other sum and sums of  
 money whatsoever and all other estate and  
 things that I have any right or power in  
 whatsoever to dispose of I do order dispose direct limit  
 and appoint the same and every part and parcel  
 thereof to the payment of my just debts funeral  
 expenses and the expenses of proving the same my toll  
 and after payment thereof into my executors  
 to and for the use and benefit provided of  
 always and I do hereby declare that neither of  
 them my said Executors and Trustees or the  
 survivors and survivor of them nor of their Executors  
 or administrators shall be answerable or accountable  
 for any more money than they or either of  
 them shall actually receive nor shall they be  
 answerable or accountable the one for the other  
 or either of them in or for any such receipts  
 payments Executors or admors but each of them  
 for himself only and for his own separate and  
 sole receipts payments Executors and admors in  
 their joining in receipts for conformity only of  
 notwithstanding, and that they my said  
 Executors and Trustees and the survivors and survivor  
 of them and Executors and administrators shall  
 and may in the first place by and out of the said  
 trust monies and premises deduct and retain for  
 themselves and himself respectively all such costs  
 charges damages and expenses as they or either  
 of them shall or may be or be put unto  
 in about touching or concerning the trusts or  
 either in them respects any of either of them  
 or any way relating thereto and I do hereby  
 nominate and appoint my said dear husband and  
 his friend John Boulton and my other

mine Joan Bolt Executor of his my will and  
sundry writing all former and other wills be made  
at any time heretofore made I do declare that the  
paper writing contained in this and the five  
preceding sheets of paper to be my only last will and  
testament and to be made in pursuance & execution  
of the power and authority to me given & received  
in and by the said writ of Settlement and all other  
powers and authorities me enabling thereto I wa  
withes waite of I the said Harriet Simon the  
testatrix have by this my last will & testament  
contained in six sheets of paper set my hand &  
seal that is to say to the first five sheets  
set my hand and to the sixth and last sheet my  
hand <sup>and seal</sup> the fiftenth day of July in the year of  
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five  
Harriet Guion (L) Signed sealed published & declared  
by the said Harriet Guion the testatrix as and  
for her last will and testament in the presence of  
us now in her presence at her request and in the  
presence of some other grave persons subscribed

prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by  
the order of Cardinal Henry Guion the husband of  
the deceased Joan Sulbert and Joan Bolt the  
executors named in the said will to whom admou was granted of  
all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the  
said deceased lady having been first sworn duly to  
administer.

This Will was proved at London on the  
twenty sixth day of March in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and seven before the  
Right Honourable Sir William Wynne Knight Doctor of  
Law Master Keeper or Commissary of the prerogative  
Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the order  
of Cardinal Henry Guion the husband of the deceased  
Joan Sulbert and Joan Bolt the executors named  
in the said will to whom admou was granted the  
having been of all and singular the goods chattels

and credits of the deceased being having been first  
 proved to wit the said Cardinal's Executors and  
 John Subbat by Commission, and the said John  
 Holt before the reverend father Samuel Pearce parson  
 Doctor of Laws and surrogate duly to administer. The  
 probate of the will of the said deceased granted in  
 the Court of August last to the said deceased's Executors  
 as of the deceased's effects being under five thousand  
 pounds having been first brought in voluntarily and  
 betwixt will and void as by acts of Court appear.
