# In the Name of God Amen

Isaac Guion still living in the parish of St. Martin in the City of London being of sound body and mind do make my will as followeth first I recommend my soul to God in the Name of his most dear and only Son Jesus Christ my only saviour and I do now leaving my body to the Earth in hope of the blessed resurrection & declare that I have heretofore given to Mary Diersey my daughter or daughter in law by her husband sufficient and above what I could give her and at present I give her one shilling only payable when she shall demand the same after my death & do discharge her from all other pretensions in what I shall leave and my will is that in case of the death of my said daughter or daughter in law without children the residue stipulated between her husband and me shall take place and be returned according to the terms of the writing passed between us & her & order my wife Lydia Guion to distribute to the poor French Protestant Refugees at her discretion the sum of twenty pounds sterling. — immediately after my decease and as for all the residue of the goods chattels and credits and other things which I shall leave belonging to me at the time of my decease I do give that the said Lydia my wife shall make an inventory thereof immediately after my decease — and that she shall retain the whole and enjoy the same until my son Isaac Guion shall attain the age of twenty one years. — I do complement and that then my said wife divide the same equally with him and deliver to him the moiety of the amount of the said inventory and in the meantime my said wife shall maintain and bring up our said son and shall make him continue and finish his study and shall lay out what shall be necessary of the capital if the income of what I shall leave should not be sufficient and as for the other moiety of my goods my said wife shall dispose thereof at her will and pleasure and in case of the death of my said son before the age of twenty one years without lawful children what I have above bequeathed him shall be long to my said wife to dispose thereof at her will and pleasure I do name and constitute the said Lydia my wife sole executrix of this my will and administration of my goods and effects & do revoke and make void all former wills and dispositions and declare this to be my last and will that the same may avail as such In witness whereof I have signed and sealed this my said will in London the twenty sixth day of April one thousand seven hundred and eighteen Isaac Guion signed sealed pronounced and declared by the said Isaac Guion to be his last will and testament in presence of us Jacob Diersey, Sam. Dupuy, Isaac Diersey — Not. pub. 1718.

body but of sound and perfect mind memory and understanding (praised be  
Almighty God for the same) do for the settling and disposing of the Estate  
the which it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me make this  
my last will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to  
say) Inprimis I will that all my just debts and funeral Charges be first  
fully paid and discharged then I give devise and bequeath unto my son  
John Quest if living at the time of my decease but if dead to and amongst  
my said son John's children share and share alike All and every  
such summe or summes of money that I shall or may be entitled to  
by virtue of a devise in my late deceased wife being the over plus  
money of a Chertsey Orchard by him therein devised to my son Sir Geo  
Quest my daughter Elizabeth Quest and my kinsman John Dalloway  
in Trust to be sold within Ten years from the date of my said  
last will which is dated the seven and twentieth day of March  
Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and twenty four, the summe  
of ten hundred pounds being first paid out of such money for which  
the same shall be sold But if the same Orchard and premises be  
not sold within the time for that purpose limited by my said last will  
I will then I give devise and bequeath all my over plus money share  
right title and interest in the same to my said loving daughter  
Elizabeth now wife of Thomas Littlewood of the parish of St  
Georges in the East in the County of Middlesex Brewer and her  
heirs and assigns for ever And I give devise and bequeath unto my  
son Sir Geo Quest all that my one equal and undivided fourteenth share  
or part of the murthering house standing and being in New Row in  
Birmingham aforesaid and also one equal and undivided  
fourteenth share or part of the Entry Garden way liberties privileges  
and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or appertaining  
to have and to hold the same fourteenth share or part of the said  
murthering house Entry Garden and premises with the appurtenances  
unto my said son Sir Geo Quest his heirs and assigns for ever  
Item all and singular my Apparel Rings Jewels Goods  
Chattel and personal Estate whatsoever I give and bequeath unto  
my loving daughter the said Elizabeth Littlewood whom I make  
sole executrix of this my will and hereby revoking and making void
